Classification of the substance

Classification according to Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008

Label: Not relevant – product is not classified as hazardous.

Description of first aid measures

- **Inhalation:** Remove casualty from exposure (to fresh air), ensuring one's own safety while doing so. Seek medical attention if symptoms persist.
